- 1. Please prepare reports with:
 - a. left justification,
 - b. single spacing,
 - c. double-space between paragraphs, and
 - d. Times Roman or Book Antiqua font
- 2. Reports should be limited to 600 words.
- 3. References should be provided, with complete journal names. (This is to assist readers from different disciplines in understanding journal names.) Sample references:

Brown, J. (1997). Title of paper. *Full Journal Title*, 49 (1): 000–000. Brown, J. (1998). *Title of Book*. Place: Publisher. Brown, J. (1999). Title of chapter. In: *Title of Book*, ed. J. Smith & M. Smith. Place: Publisher, pp. 000–000. Freud, S. (1923). The ego and the id. In Strachey, J. (Ed.), *The standard edition of the complete pyschological works of Sigmund Freud* (Vol. 19, 3–63). London: The Hogarth Press Ltd.

- 5. When you email your report, please give your Word files the following title: "Bulletin [your city or country] month year" (for example, "Bulletin Argentina June 2015.doc").
